The Taxpayer Advocate Service (TAS) will be available to assist taxpayers with tax problems they've been unable to resolve on their own with the IRS. If your tax problem meets our criteria, we'll assign a Case Advocate to work directly with you. Our goal is to provide personalized, step by step guidance.

TAS's presentation will help taxpayers who opt to self-prepare returns avoid common filing and processing errors that cause refund delays and other IRS tax related issues. Nevada Free Taxes Coalition will be on site to help taxpayer file prior year (2015 - 2018) tax returns for qualified taxpayers.

The Taxpayer Advocate Service is an *independent* organization within the Internal Revenue Service. TAS helps taxpayers resolve tax problems, recommends changes to prevent future tax problems, and protects taxpayer rights. TAS's *services are free* to taxpayers who are:

- Experiencing a financial hardship or having financial difficulties because of a tax problem;
- Trying, but haven't been able to resolve an IRS tax problem; or
- Believing an IRS system or procedure isn't working.
