TAS will meet with you in-person to discuss your IRS tax problems. Please bring the information you'd like to discuss with TAS such as copies of your federal income tax returns, IRS letters and notices, and any related tax records. Also bring your state issued identification.

TAS is an **independent** organization within the IRS. TAS helps taxpayers resolve tax problems, recommends changes to prevent future tax problems, and protects taxpayer rights. TAS's **services are free** to taxpayers who are:

- Experiencing a financial hardship or having financial difficulties because of a tax problem;
- Trying, but haven't been able to resolve an IRS tax problem; or
- Believing an IRS system or procedure isn't working.
